Holy Father's intention: For a Christian response to bioethical challenges. We pray for Christians facing new bioethical challenges; may they continue to defend the dignity of all human life with prayer and action.

Dear Rev Fathers, Sisters and Lay faithful, Jai Christ! Greetings of Peace in the Lord!

I am delighted to know some of the innovative programmes organized by our Commission Secretaries. Note these immediately in your diary and announce it properly to the people on Sundays and get into action immediately. Please make best use of the opportunities offered for your people, especially the youth and children.

<u>Prayer for Peace in Ukraine</u>: During the General Audience on Wednesday, 23rd Feb 2022, Pope Francis made a heartfelt appeal for peace in Ukraine. Pope Francis says his heart aches over the situation in Ukraine and announces a Day of Fasting for Peace on Ash Wednesday.

The Holy Season of Lent: We begin the Holy Season of Lent by celebrating the Ash Wednesday on 2nd March. Our beloved Pope Francis in his Lenten message based on letter to the Galetians 5: 9-10 has exhorted us: "Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity, let us do good to all." Beginning with the image of sowing and reaping, the Holy Father points out that "Lent invites us to conversion, to a change in mindset, so that life's truth and beauty may be found not so much in possessing as in giving, not so much in accumulating as in sowing and sharing good news..." I am sending you the summary of this message along with an appeal to all our people to take up Lenten practices desiring a true conversion of heart. Please distribute the same along with mite boxes to all families on or before the Ash Wednesday.

Lent invites us to pray and meditate on Christ's passion and death. It encourages the acts of charity and acts of mercy and a time of grace for those who neglect their spiritual life living in worldliness, to turn back to the Lord. Let this season draw us closer to the Cross of Christ, attract to the poverty of Christ and grow in richness of Christ. I request all Parish Priests/ Mission Directors/Sisters to organize various Lenten programmes in the Parishes/Zonal Levels where all faithful may be encouraged to meditate on the Passion of Christ and prepare well for the Easter celebration.

You are aware Inter-national Women's Day is celebrated on 8th March. It is a great day for all women, especially those under the Women Empowerment Programme. Thanks to all at ORBIT and Seva Sangama and other FBOs working for women development and specially our religious Sisters who along with social workers and animators work hard work for women empowerment. Happy Women's Day! I request all Parish Priests/

Mission directors to take initiative for organizing Women's Day in your respective mission centers and parishes on the theme: ಸಾಮರಸ್ಯ ಸಮಾನತೆ ನಮ್ಮ ಶಿಲ್ಪಿ ನಾವೇ (Saamarasya, Samaanathe, Namma Shilpi Naave) and make it a Day for all the women. Anniversary of the election as Supreme pontiff of Pope Francis (2013): Cardinal George Mario Bergoglio was chosen as the 266th pontiff in the Church on 13th March2013 and inspired by the great example of St Francis of Assisi, he chose to be called 'Francis'. We thank God for leading the church throughout the world through the inspiring leadership of Pope Francis. Let us earnestly pray God to bless him with good health and guidance of the Holy Spirit, and at the same time let us also work for fulfilling his aspirations and teachings in our life.

Solemnity of St Joseph (March 19): St. Joseph is the patron saint of the Catholic Church, unborn children, fathers, migrants and workers. He is honored as the Patron of many Parishes and Institutions in our Diocese. He is a father for every Christian family. I invite the youth in every parish to take initiative to celebrate the Feast of St Joseph honoring their own fathers during the celebration.
