HOLY FATHER'S INTENTION: We pray for Health Care workers who serve the sick and the elderly, especially in the poorest countries; may they be adequately supported by governments and local communities.

Dear Rev Fathers, Sisters and Lay faithful, Jai Christ! Greetings of Peace in the Lord!

CHRISM MASS: will be celebrated on Thursday, 7th April 2022 at 05.00p.m in the Cathedral. It is a blessed occasion we come together, particularly the priests along with the Bishop united in Christ the High Priest to bless the Oil of Chrism and Oil of Catechumen and Oil of Anointing the Sick. Please exhort all the religious and the lay faithful to attend the Mass...

It is also a day of Prayer and Recollection for all the Priests and the Religious. Rev. Dr. Joseph Titus, Professor of Scripture has kindly consented to be the Resource Person of the day. Hence, the programme of the day begins with the Prayer at 10.00 a.m sharp and ends with the Chrism Mass at 05.00 p.m. I expect all of you to be present. Just as we have prepared our people, let us spiritually prepare ourselves for the celebration of the Paschal Triduum.

THE PASCHAL TRIDUUM (Holy Week)

The Paschal Triduum begins at sunset on Holy Thursday when Christ accomplishes the work of Redemption and enters into the glory. We commemorate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord observing the Solemn Liturgy of the Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday. The Fathers of the Second Vatican Council remind us of the extraordinary significance of the Triduum: "Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God principally through his Paschal Mystery: Dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life.' Please read diligently the instructions given in the ORDO as well as the Missal before you celebrate the Easter Triduum, and your liturgy of TRIDUUM will become meaningful, beautiful and according to the mind of the church. Wish you all a meaningful Paschal Triduum

Family Blessing during Easter: The practice of House Blessing is a beautiful tradition preserved for centuries in the Church. Visiting the parishioners in their homes during the Easter time, the Parish Priest represents the Risen Lord meeting his people in the families bringing forgiveness, Peace and hope of a new life with the Lord. I request all Parish Priests to begin Family Blessings soon after Easter and complete the same during the Easter Season.

<u>DIOCESAN SYNOD:</u> As announced before, the Diocesan Synod will take place at the Cathedral on Thursday, 21st April 2022. The programme of the day will begin at 09.30 a.m and will end with Eucharistic Celebration followed by lunch at 02.00p.m. I invite all the

priests, superiors of the religious communities and Vice-president and Secretaries of the Mission Centres and Parishes to be present.

The Diocese is planning two important new initiatives the success of which will depend on your involvement and cooperation. They are:

- (A) **Apostolic School** at Sacred Heart Minor Seminary, Sirnoor: We welcome children (Std 8th to 10th) who have aptitude to become a priest to join the Sacred Heart Apostolic School (Minor Seminary). We need your help to identify at least one candidate from your parish/mission centre. Please keep this need of the diocese in mind. Please promote Vocations by personally speaking to the children from good families about their willingness to become priests and also their parents. When you have finalized, please inform Fr David D'Souza to do the follow up. I expect at least one candidate from each of your missions/parishes. Boys who have completed SSLC, PUC and degree and wish to become priests may be directed to meet me Along with the parents on Sunday 8th MAY 2022.
- (B) **SANKALPA Hostel** in view of promoting children to Civil Services: Children with exceptional intelligence (A+) in all the subjects will be accepted at the SANKALPA Hostel at the GDES, Bishop House Campus to be given all the soft skills and motivation to achieve their heart's ambition for minimum fees. More of it will be explained to you in the next Circular. Please popularize these programmes among the people and children. Please contact Fr Stevan Veigas for further details (mob 9449273504).

SUMMER CAMPS 2022: After a long break we are glad to organise the summer camps and make our children's Summer Holidays fruitful. I request the Directors/Parish Priests to organise these camps. For want of personnel and other infra-structure facilities, you are free to join other centres. You are expected to get the budget approved before you take up the following activities:

- 1. FAITH FORMATION CAMP to be held at your Missions/Parishes on 9 17 April 2022 for all children from Std IV to IX. The Commission for the Catechetics will be circulating the daily time-table along the lessons and other teaching material of the Faith Formation Camp. These lessons provide you with only the required basic material. The teacher must study them, take pain to prepare the lessons suitable to the class one is teaching adding his or her faith experience. You can enrich the lesson by giving better examples, adding appropriate songs, action songs, dramatization etc. Make your lessons more and more experiential and let it be a joyful faith experience for our children receiving the knowledge of faith, values and convictions.
- **2. PRERANA camp (April 18-30):** is aimed at giving a boost to all children to look forward to studying next academic year well prepared. It is an opportunity especially for children going to government schools. You are welcome to hold Prerana Camp for all children from Std 1 to 9th desiring to study especially those deprived of good education in their villages. The afternoon time can be utilized to help children to write, read, dance, act, games etc., Let there be Prayer, Bhajans, Mass and Rosary every day. Include some educative films too. Please engage good teachers and able Camp Masters. Again, please get the budget approved before you begin the camp.
- **3. SANKALPA CAMP (April 21 May 9):** will be organized only for A and A plus students of Std VIII, IX and X of the coming Academic Year. Please be consistent in promoting the

children to this Camp. It is meant children with higher intelligence capacity. Possibly, we'll promote them for civil services through the Sankalpa hostel at GDES. Please note, those not eligible will be sent back. Fr Stevan Veigas(mob 9449273504), Secretaary of GDES will give you further details.


