We wish you a very fruitful stay and a rich mission experience. My sincere thanks to your Provincial Superiors, for their special concern for this mission diocese. I thank God for giving us two new priests: Fr. Sachin Christi and Fr. Abhishek Moses. We warmly welcome them to the diocese. I also take this opportunity to express deep gratitude to all the Priests, Sisters, and Brothers who served this diocese and now called to serve the Lord in other places. May God bless you abundantly.

Pope announces 2 new Cardinals from India: His Grace Filipe Neri Ferrão (69), Metropolitan Archbishop of Goa and Daman and the President of the CCBI and His grace Anthony Poola (60) Archbishop of Hyderabad are elevated as Cardinals by Pope Francis on Sunday, 29th May 2022. It is indeed joyous news for all of us and the Indian Catholic Church. As we thank God for their elevation, we congratulate them and assure our prayers for a great leadership from them in the Indian church and Society.

Mission Orientation Programme: is organized Deanery wise. For Bidar Deanery it is on Saturday 11th at Yesu Nilaya, Bhalki at 9:00 am, for Gulbarga Deanery on Sunday 12th at 10:30 am at Sugyan, and for Vijayapura Deanery on Sunday 19th at St. Ann Church Vijayapura. As this programme will explain our mission approach and the thrust areas of our mission work here this year, it is important and mandatory for all. I request all the Parish Priest, Mission Directors and the Superiors of the Religious houses to attend this programme. All others also are welcome. Your presence will make a difference for us on that day and for you all through your days of service here. We pray for the fresh outpouring of the Spirit that we may be effective evangelisers working as one family. Very Rev. Fr. Praveen D'Souza, Provincial Superior of the Congregation of Franciscans has kindly consented to be the resource person of the day. Kindly mark these dates in your calendar. The diocese will soon publish the Year Plan as well as the Directory of the Diocese. Please send the requested information at the earliest, by 10th June.

<u>Parish/Mission Centre Pastoral Plan:</u> Every parish/mission centre should have a year plan. The copy of the Year Plan will soon be in your hands. Keeping room for the diocesan level programmes, all Mission Directors/Parish Priests along with the PPT and PPC shall prepare the Year Plan 2022-23 latest by 15th of June. Remember the saying, 'well begun is half done!'

As the new Academic Year begins, it is important that our children and youth get admitted to good school and colleges. The diocese, as you know will give admission to all catholic children and also gives 50% concession to the poor. I request you dear Fathers, sisters to give proper guidance and motivation to the children and see that they are well placed in the society tomorrow.

<u>The Good Will Mission Group</u> has approved 6 coaching centres in villages. Those of you who wish to start a coaching centre shall ensure the following: A group of at least 30-60 children attending the tuition classes(list of names), request letter from the parents, identify a good reliable tuition teacher, a place for the teacher to stay, and ensure supervision at least once a week. First come, first served. The classes should begin by 15th June. I also thank the Good Will Mission Group members for sponsoring the studies of 72 children this year.

<u>Feasts and Solemnities in the month of June</u>: We are glad to begin the mission calendar year in this month of June full of feasts and solemnities, namely, Pentecost Celebration (5th June), Feast of the Holy Trinity (12th June), Corpus Christi (19th June), Nativity of St John the Baptist (23 June), Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (24th), Feast of St Peter and Paul (29th June). As we celebrate these feasts and solemnities with due reverence, may they fill us with abundant divine graces to serve the Lord faithfully.

<u>Sankalpa Study Home:</u> for Boys and Girls (Std VIII-X) will soon be started for our intelligent and talented Catholic children at Gulbarga. During their study the children will be trained and motivated to aim at Civil Services. Please speak to the children about these programmes and motivate them. Please pray for the success of these programmes.

<u>Sacred heart Apostolic School:</u> is started at our Minor Seminary Sirnoor, Gulbarga. I am glad 6 Candidates have responded to the Lords Call and joined us

Training Youth on Leadership Skill ('Social Inclusion & Democracy'):

This training is to provide our Youth an easy access to broaden their intellectual horizon and sharpen their leadership skills and develop a humane perspective so that they can effectively play the role of organic intellectuals for their communities in their areas. Democratisation of knowledge, deeper appreciation of the Constitutional provisions, strengthening local governance, developing democratic culture and promoting inclusive approach to human development are some of the primary objectives of this unit. This training will be organised by the 'INDIAN SOCIAL INSTITUTE' Bangalore. You may have noticed that we have problems in villages only where we do not have good leaders.

We need to finalise the list of participants by at least 15th June. Directors, please hurry up to do the needful in this regard.

Ruby Anniversary of 'Bidar Mission': Bidar mission completes 40 years on 17th June. It was on this day the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus the Bidar Mission was started. We know, the Lord has done marvels for us through this mission venture of the diocese of Mangalore. We gratefully remember late Bishop Basil S D' Souza for taking up this mission, Bishop Emeritus Aloysius Paul D' Souza for continuing the good work until it became a diocese. Priests, sisters and Brothers who worked in this mission in the last 40 years. I invite all of you to organize Eucharistic Adoration and Thanksgiving on Friday 17th to thank the Lord for the gift of Bidar Mission that paved the way to Gulbarga Diocese. So also, let's thank God for all the blessings on Bidar Mission and the Diocese on Friday 24th, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
