The Council of Priests Meeting - 13th July

Due to KRCBC meeting on 5-8 July, we had to change the dates of our programmes in the diocese. Accordingly, we will be having the Council of Priests' meeting and Consultors meeting on Wednesday 13th July at 10.00 am and 2.30 pm respectively. The agenda will be sent by the secretary to all the members in time. You are welcome to suggest any other issue or problems that that you feel these bodies should take note of and deliberate.

Deanery Pastoral Council Meeting – 10th July:

As per our Year Plan, the deanery Pastoral Council Meeting is to be held on Sunday 10th July. The Deans shall convene this meeting in their respective deanery on the theme: Lay Leadership. The summary of the Synodal consultation on Lay leadership will be discussed at this meeting and they shall make suitable suggestions which again will be taken up at the Council of Priests at its meeting on the 13th July

<u>Monthly Recollection</u>: Dear Fathers and Sisters Monthly recollection of the Clergy and Religious Priests (Superiors) will be held on Thursday on 14th July. The Programme will begin at 9:30 sharp and will end at 1:30 followed by lunch. I expect the superiors of the Religious community to be present too. Those of you who are not able to reach in time on Thursday are welcome to stay at Sugyan on the previous evening you may please complete your accounts and other works leisurely. You are dearly welcome to Kripalaya always. Kindly inform Mons. Stany Lobo and Dn. Aron.

Educational Loan for College Studies: You are aware that we have offered to pay the college fees as Educational Loan for students seeking admission in catholic colleges to degree, diploma or other professional courses. This special benefit of paying the college fees is only for the poor catholic students whose parents are landless laborers or who do not have a fixed income. I hope our youth will come forward to take up education in a Catholic College which ensures a good exposure to our youth, quality teaching and also their Christian upbringing. They will certainly know their potential better, grow in self-confidence and will be better prepared to face their future. As you promote them for studies in catholic colleges please

remember to make sure the student has passed with 70 percent marks, well motivated and needs support, faithful to the church. Make sure also they enroll themselves to the college paying 25percent of the college fees (which will be refunded to them by the end of the year. It is advisable that the Parish Priests/Students desiring to study contact the Youth Director who will suggest the placement as he is in touch with different colleges and technical training institutes. He will also work for concessions in fees. Parish Priests shall issue the Recommendation letter only after he makes sure all the norms of GDES are fulfilled. The Parish Priests/Directors shall send all the Applications of the students to the Secretary GDES along with all the required documents.(marks card copy, Adhar card copy, SCST/ income certificate, affidavit and the recommendation letter) as early as possible and before the colleges close admissions.

Last but not the least, I feel our youth will not come forward to take up this offer unless you, Fathers and Sisters motivate and guide them. But it's worth doing so especially for the sake of those well motivated ones. Please reach out to them. Let's do for them whatever is possible and see that they are well pleased. Please announce this provision during the coming Sunday Announcement

<u>Feast of St. Thomas - July 3:</u> India our motherland is indeed blessed to have been evangelized by St Thomas, one of the twelve Apostles of Jesus. St Thomas preached the Gospel to India and died a martyr on our soil. When Jesus' life was at risk by returning to Judea after Lazarus had died, the Apostle Thomas courageously told his fellow disciples they should go with Jesus, no matter what the danger (John 11:16). It is an invitation for us to be ready to give ourselves to the mission of the Lord in this present situation. Let us take the example of St. Thomas the apostle as we work in different mission places, seek his intercession for the smooth running of our mission works.

This day is also observed as the **Indian Christian Day:** This declaration, the Indian Christian Day (Yeshu Bhakti Divas) as an annual day of remembrance, is for all the followers of the Lord Jesus Christ, of Indian origin, to celebrate the person and message of JESUS CHRIST brought to India in 52 AD by St. Thomas the Apostle one of his twelve disciples. This day, historically observed as St. Thomas Day, commemorates the martyrdom of the Apostle in 72 AD near Chennai. In observing this day as Indian Christian Day as followers of the Lord Jesus, let us preserve our identity within the Indian cultural heritage, uniting with all who wish to celebrate, irrespective of language, custom, creed, region or religion. Please make proper announcements about the importance of this day to all your people.

<u>Feast of St. James – July 25</u>: St. James is the brother of John the Evangelist. The two were called by Jesus as they worked with their father in a fishing boat on the Sea of Galilee. He had the privilege of witnessing the Transfiguration, the raising to life of the daughter of Jairus, and the agony of Jesus in the garden of Gethsemani. He was the first apostle to die a martyr's death. We emulate his zeal and courage in following Christ in spreading the faith in difficult times.

<u>Feast of St Joachim and St. Ann – July 26</u>: This feast in honour of the parents of our Blessed Mother Mary as per the good advice of the Holy Father Pope Francis is to be celebrated honouring our elderly people in a meaningful way and they feel the love and care of their children and grandchildren. I invite the Youth of the parish to take initiative and celebrate the feast with great love and gratitude to our grandparents.

<u>Saint Alphonsa Muttathupadathu – July 28:</u> She is a Syro-Malabar Catholic and Franciscan Religious nun, first woman and second person of Indian origin canonized as a Saint. She was locally known as Alphonsa Amma, suffered most of her life due to different sickness, but she offered everything to God. Let us thank God for this great saint who is the inspiration for many of us to live a dedicated life in all the limitations.

Norms to deal against sexual abuse of the minors and other vulnerables : You are aware the church observes zero tolerance against anyone committing sexual abuse of the minors and the vulnerable in our institutions and church premises. It is made mandatory to serve the staff in our institutions the norms and guidelines that deal with such crimes. These have been sent to you earlier through the Circular. 
In the News:

- <u>Sankalpa Study Home (For Girls and Boys) was inaugurated At Sugyan</u> on 2nd June. It's a program aimed at promoting the clever children to Civil Services. - <u>The Mission Orientation Programme</u> this year was organized Deanery wise. The Bishop described the growth of the Diocese from its very inception. . Rev Fr. Stany Lobo, Vicar General gave insight into the pastoral plan of the diocese. Fr Gerald Sagar insisted on

knowing the people and their culture in order to serve as better missionaries. Fr Clary D'Souza shared on the essence of the mission and our dynamics.

- <u>Young Students Movement (YSM) Animators and Leaders' Training</u>: took place at Sugyan, the Diocesan Pastoral Centre at Kotnoor on 24 25 June 2022. 98 YSM students and 20 animators were introduced to the essence and purpose of the YSM in schools. A number of sessions were given by eminent resource persons for both students and animators, including icebreakers, games, and action songs. Fr Anil D'Sa, Youth Director of the Archdiocese of Bangalore and Asian Chaplin for YCS/YSM, and Rev Fr. Christuraj SDB, the diocesan youth director were the resource persons for the event. During the stage programme the people who built the stage were honored. The bishop congratulated Fr Mark, the Director. He also explained and reminded the people of the work put in by the missionaries in the past 20 years and urged the people to be grateful to God for them. In his speech he remembered with gratitude F.r Victor Machado, Fr. Joseph Rodrigues and other who worked hard for the growth of this mission. He also wished that the Mission Centre would continue to do many good works in the future too
