### In the News:

- <u>Media Awareness Program For High School Students</u>: Commission for Social Communication organized an awareness program on Social Media for High School and PUC students on 1<sup>st</sup> July at Premanjali School, Ujini and Deepalaya School, Santhpur. Fr Clevan Gomes and Fr Roshan D'Souza conducted this programme. Students and Staff attentively participated and benefited from the programme.
- <u>MCA (Missionary Childhood Association) Animator's Training Program at Bhalk</u>i (30<sup>th</sup> June 2022.): Bishop Robert Miranda and Fr Gerald Sagar, the director of MCA were the resource persons of the day who shared the information on History of MCA, the role of the MCA Animators, and suggested some practical activities for the year 2022-23. There were 57 participants actively took part in the session. Similar training was also held at Gulbarga deanery.
- <u>Ruby Jubilee Celebration of Bidar Mission at St. Joseph's Church, Bidar (4th July)</u>: Ruby Jubilee celebration began thanking the Lord for all the blessings received before the Eucharist, followed by the Solemn Eucharistic celebration presided over by the Bishop. There was also a stage programme held at St. Joseph Church community Hall during which he growth of the Bidar Mission was displayed by a PPT. Several dignitaries of the city graced the event. daily purpled with your Precious Blood.


Keep pure and unearthly their hearts,
