Dear Brother Priests, Sisters and Lay Faithful, Jai Christ!

The National Director of Pontifical Mission Society in his letter says: "This year's MISSION SUNDAY is very special because of various jubilees: We celebrate the Ouadricentennial (400th Anniversary) of the foundation of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples; the Bicentenary of the founding of the Pontifical Mission Society of the Propagation of the Faith (POPF); and the Centenary of the "Pontifical" designation of three of the four Pontifical Mission Societies (The Pontifical Mission Society of the Propagation of the Faith, The Pontifical Society of the Missionary Childhood & The Pontifical Society of St. Peter the Apostle). This is also the year that the Church beatified our beloved foundress, Blessed Pauline Marie Jaricot in Lyon, France this past May 22nd. These milestones are great incentives for all of us to continue with renewed zeal and commitment in missionary animation and financial support. The Holy Father's message for the World Mission Day 2022 with the chosen theme, reminds us of our joyful mission commitment: YOU SHALL BE MY WITNESSES (Acts 1:8). Pope reflects on three key phrases, namely -

- 'You shall be my witnesses,' The call of every Christian to bear witness to Christ;
- the ends of the earth,' The perennial relevance of a mission of universal evangelization;
- You will receive power' from the Holy Spirit The significance of being strengthened and guided by the Spirit.

We request you dear Fathers, Sisters and Lay Brethren, for a more meaningful and creative celebration of this world event in our parishes and institutions, to ignite the spirit of mission in all our people. I hope by now you have received the Jathra prayer and handbill for Jathra-Utsav 22. Please introduce and pray this Prayer after communion at Sunday Mass. For the time being until Jathra gets over, we'll stop praying the prayer for the Synod. We'll resume it after the Jathra. There will be a digital visual presentation on the Journey of our Diocese at the Jathra Utsav. Fr. Roshan D' Souza, Secretary of the Commission for Communication will do the needful in this regard. Please cooperate.

October month dedicated to Mary, our Lady of Rosary: Because of the mission she received from God, her life is most closely linked with the mysteries of Jesus Christ, and there is no one who has followed in the footsteps of the Incarnate Word more closely and with more merit than she". Pope Francis has invited all the faithful to recite the Holy Rosary, that "sweet chain that links heaven and earth", during the month of October. The Rosary stands revealed as a dynamic teacher and nurturer of Christian faith, morality, and spiritual perfection, fostering in various ways faith, hope, charity, and other virtues, and mediating special graces, all to the end that we may become more and more like unto Christ. Kindly promote prayer of Rosary in the church and families.

<u>Jeevan Jyothi Camp</u>: Jeevan Jyothi camp will be organized at Bhalki on 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> October for the students of 10th and PUC. Please encourage our catholic students of Std X, PUC I & II to attend this camp. It is an important camp where we motivate our students to take Jesus as their life partner, guide, Lord and Savior. Parish Priests, please see that all your students participate in it. The certificate they are given in this camp is a very important document required in all the future needs.

<u>First Holy Communion and Confirmation Preparation:</u> A Gentle reminder to all Parish Priests to make use of the October *Dasara* Holidays to prepare children for the first Holy Communion. Also, you may please make use of *Diwali* Holidays (4 full days) for preparing children for Confirmation.

<u>Communion distribution:</u> As our people do not seem to receive Holy Communion with clean hands and proper devotion, and also to avoid non-catholics receiving the Communion, I request the priests to revert back to our former custom of serving the Holy Communion on the tongue. Thank God, Corona is over. All people, including the Sisters, should receive Holy Communion devoutly on the tongue as before. Priests are not permitted to administer communion in both species.
