Dear Rev Fathers, Sisters and Brothers, JAI KHRISTA!

God called back to himself the Humble Servant of his Vineyard, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI: The 95-year-old Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI passed away on Saturday at 9:34 AM in his residence at the Vatican's Mater Ecclesiae Monastery. He Shepherded the Church from 2005 until his resignation in 2013 due to ill health. It was he who erected our diocese of Gulbarga and appointed me as the first Bishop on 24-06-2005. May God welcome him into His eternal abode.

Thank you very much for the meaningful and fruitful celebration of Christmas. I am pleased to know in all parishes, mission centers, villages and institutions the Christmas celebration went on beautifully well. I also thank you for your personal greetings. May God be praised for helping us to celebrate the birthday of our Lord with our people, and especially with people of other faiths. Indeed, it was a grand Christmas all over. There was a huge crowd of people of other faiths at Vijayapura church and Gulbarga Cathedral. People were found to be very eager to visit the church and have a 'Darshan' of the Lord Jesus. I appreciate all of you who organized an Inte-Religious Christmas Celebration as part of Christmas in villages, Mission centres or Parish. Thank you. The 'Christmas Mela' the first of its kind at Ekamba Mission was also good success. Congratulation to Fr. Anil Crasta and his Team.

Feast of Epiphany (Jan 8): The Feast of the Epiphany celebrates Jesus' first appearance to the Gentiles, represented by the Magi. After being made known to the shepherds of Bethlehem He is revealed to the Magi who came from the East to adore Him. Through this event Jesus becomes the Light to the Gentiles. The focus of the Epiphany is an affirmation of actual mission of Jesus' arrival on earth namely, Peace and Salvation for all people on earth.

Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (Jan 9): The Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord on Sunday, 8th January. This brings the Season of Christmas to an end. The Church recalls our Lord's second manifestation or Epiphany which occurred on the occasion of His Baptism in the river Jordan, where the Father reveals his Son and the Spirit. Jesus' baptism reminds us of our mission: to experience the presence of God within us, to live as the children of God and witnessing Christian life.

Word of God Sunday (Jan 22): The Word of God is a Lamp for my steps and Light to my path. Let us all strive hard to lead our flock according to the Word of God. Let us teach our faithful to know and love the Word of God, and grow in a habit of daily reading of the Word of God personally or during family prayer /rosary.

Prayer Week for the Unity of all Christians (Jan 18—25): is observed in the church between 18-25 of January on the theme: "Do good; seek justice." The entire scriptural passage for the theme is Isaiah 1:12-18, lamenting a lack of justice among the People of God. Yet, it also promises redemption by encouraging acts of justice. Today, separation and oppression continue to manifest and the systemic perpetuation of racism is still prevalent. Its existence has unfairly benefitted some, including churches, and burdened and excluded others. Therefore, it is an invitation for us to ensure Christian commitment to justice and mercy and pray for the people who suffer. I request the Directors, Parish Priests to make an intention everyday during the week and also have an interdenominational prayer meeting at least once during the week.

Republic Day (January 26): India celebrates 74th Republic Day on the 26th of January 2023 remembering Constitution of India that came into effect in the year 1950. Being an Indian, we too are fully responsible for what happens in our country. We should not let go priceless sacrifices of Freedom Fighters and make this country a slave of corruption, inequality and social discrimination, It is necessary to wake up from our slumber and speak to the people on the sacredness and importance of the Constitution in order to save this country from peril. Let us therefore, observe this National Feast urging the people to raise their voice against any violation of the principles laid in the Sacred Book of the Nation, the Constitution. Make it an important day in the life of your people around.
