

HOLY FATHER'S INTENTION: We pray for the spread of peace and non-violence, by decreasing the use of weapons by States and citizens.

Dear Rev Fathers, Sisters and Lay faithful, Jai Christ! Greetings of Peace in the Lord! We begin the Holy Week on Sunday 2nd April. I wish and pray the liturgy at your parish /mission becomes a faith experience and catechesis to all the faithful. Please prepare well all things especially Word of God you are preaching on these solemn celebrations. The Paschal Triduum begins at sunset on Holy Thursday when Christ accomplishes the work of Redemption and enters into the glory. We commemorate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord observing the Solemn Liturgy of the Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday. The Fathers of the Second Vatican Council remind us of the extraordinary significance of the Triduum: "Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God principally through his Paschal Mystery: Dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life." Please read diligently the instructions given in the ORDO as well as the Missal before you celebrate the Easter Triduum, and your liturgy of TRIDUUM will become meaningful, beautiful and according to the mind of the church. Wish you all a meaningful Paschal Triduum

Family Blessing during Easter: The practice of House Blessing is a beautiful tradition preserved for centuries in the Church. Visiting the parishioners in their homes during the Easter time, the Parish Priest represents the Risen Lord meeting his people in the families bringing forgiveness, Peace and hope of a new life with the Lord. I request all Parish Priests to begin Family Blessings soon after Easter and complete the same before the Easter Season ends.

SANKALPA Hostel in view of promoting children to Civil Services: Children with exceptional intelligence (A+) in all the subjects will be accepted at the SANKALPA Hostel at the GDES, Bishop House Campus to be given all the soft skills and motivation to achieve their heart's ambition for minimum fees. SUMMER CAMPS 2022: After a long break we are glad to organise the summer camps and make our children's Summer Holidays fruitful. I request the Directors/Parish Priests to organise these camps. For want of personnel and other infra-structure facilities, you are free to join other centres. You are expected to get the budget approved before you take up the following activities:

a. FAITH FORMATION CAMP to be held at your Missions/Parishes on 1 - 9 April 2023 for all children from Std IV to IX. The Commission for the Catechetics has prepared the lessons and other teaching material for you. These lessons provide you with only the required basic material. The teacher must study them, take pain to prepare the lessons

suitable to the class one is teaching adding his or her faith-experience. You can enrich the lesson by giving better examples, adding appropriate songs, action songs, dramatization etc. Make your lessons more and more experiential and let it be a joyful faith experience for our children receiving the knowledge of faith, values and convictions.

b. PRERANA Camp (April 11 -30): is aimed at giving a boost to all children to look forward to studying next academic year well prepared. It is an opportunity especially for children going to government schools. You are welcome to hold Prerana Camp for all children from Std 1 to 9th desiring to study especially those deprived of good education in the villages. The afternoon time can be utilized to help children to know their talents organizing various faith formation and cultural activities. Let there be Prayer, *Bhajans*, Mass and Rosary every day. Include some educative films too. Please engage good teachers and able Camp Masters. Also, please get the budget approved before you begin the camp.

c. SANKALPA CAMP (April 11 -30): will be organized only for A and A plus students of Std VIII, IX and X (of the coming Academic Year). Please take care in sending the children to this Camp, as it is meant only for intelligent children or above average. Possibly, we'll promote them for civil services through the Sankalpa Hostel at GDES. Please note, those not eligible will be sent back. Fr Steevan Veigas (mob 9449273504), Secretaary of GDES will give you further details.

Summer Ministry for Brothers: Welcome to our Brothers studying in major seminaries in Mangalroe and Bangalore who have come for their summer ministry.

SINCHANA – the diocesan bulletin: We thank Fr Baapu and his Team for regularly publishing SINCHANA, the bi-monthly bulletin of our diocese. So far, we have been distributing it free of cost. It is time we own it. I request all the Parish Priests, Mission directors, heads of the institutions to appeal to the people and get as many subscriptions as possible paying only Rs100-00 a year(April- Marsh). Devine Mercy Sunday (16th): Divine Mercy Sunday feast falls on the Sunday after Easter Sunday. It is a celebration of the revelations of Jesus Christ to St. Faustina Kowalska, in the early 20th century. The message of Divine Mercy is one of love, forgiveness, and compassion. It emphasizes the infinite mercy of God and encourages all people to trust in Jesus and his mercy. On this Sunday, encourage people to go to confession, receive Holy Communion, recite of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, venerating the image of the Divine Mercy, symbolizing his mercy and love of God for all people.

Mark the Evangelist (25th): St. Mark the Evangelist, also known as John Mark, was one of the four Evangelists who wrote the Gospels in the New Testament. He was born in Cyrene, a city in North Africa, of Jewish descent. St. Mark accompanied St. Paul and St. Barnabas on their first missionary journey, but he later returned to Jerusalem. He also traveled with St. Peter as his interpreter. Mark wrote his Gospel in Rome around AD 70, based on the teachings of St. Peter. The Gospel of Mark is the shortest of the four Gospels and focuses on the actions and deeds of Jesus rather than his teachings. Mark is also credited with founding the church in Alexandria, Egypt, and is venerated as the patron saint of that city. According to tradition, Mark was martyred in Alexandria in the late 1st century AD. His symbol is the winged lion, which represents courage and strength.

Good Shepherd Sunday (Prayer for vocation)(30): "Good Shepherd Sunday" is also known as "Vocation Sunday". It is the fourth Sunday of Easter reflecting Jesus as the Good Shepherd who lays down his life for his sheep. This day celebrated as a day to reflect on the Call to Priesthood and Religious life and praying for those who are discerning their vocations. Please promote vocations in our families and Parish/Mission Centre by meeting children and their parents and prepare to send at least one aspirant to the Apostolic School.


