- The MCA Group leaders will bring along with them their savings (mite box) to offer it to the Lord during the offertory at the concluding Mass.
- Each zone is given an activity to be presented at the cultural programme. Please help children to prepare the best way.
- Each Zone will help the children for the Grand Infant Jesus procession with its own creativity.
- Children from every zone are given a theme to enact the life of one saint (15 minutes). So also, from every zone there will be one child performing Bible Patana, speech on, 'The saint I love most' (3 minutes each). Due to time constraint, Parish Priests are requested to share the above items among your parishes or mission centres in consensus.
- There will be prize given to the best MCA group in the parish and also the best Lay Animator. The Parish Priests are requested to select and send their names before 7th February.

Criteria for selecting the best MCA: Regular meetings, active in liturgy, church service and programmes, savings, able office bearers (leadership) and overall performance.

Criteria to select the best Lay Animator: Commitment to MCA ministry, ability to motivate MCA Group, Children's attachment to the animator. This is only to encourage the Lay animators. So if you don't have any, you may drop this proposal.
