Dear Fathers, Sisters and brethren, Jai Christa,

I had a great learning from brother Bishops at 36th CBCI General Body Meeting at St John's National Academy of Health Sciences, Bangalore from 30th January to 7th February on the theme: Church's Response to the Current Socio-Political Situation in the Country and the Benefits and Challenges of Artificial Intelligence. I learnt a lot from the experience of a number of Bishops I met. Sorry to say that many Bishops are facing problems from the fundamentalists in their dioceses. Compared to those dioceses we are blessed to be serving the Lord by and large in a peaceful atmosphere. There are places where the missions are vibrant and missionaries are working under many adverse situations. Let's remember to pray for them always.

The church, in India is facing great challenges in the current socio-political situations. The least we can do in this context is to educate our people to vote for a secular party. Let's do this in all earnestness. We also felt, prayer is the only weapon we have to fight the enemy. The church in India has invited all people to observe Friday 22nd March as a day of prayer and fasting. Please instruct your people of the importance of this day of prayer and fast and organize the same at the parish in an appropriate way. The recent incident in Mangalore (Gerosa School) is only a sign how the communal forces are working. Let us be vigilant, 'Gentle like the dove and shrewd as snakes' as the Lord puts it (Mt 10:16). We are planning to organize a 'Legal Cell' in the diocese. Please pray that it may be successful. Please take some time and read the enclosed statement of the CBCI and get to know the mind of the church on all matters including AI (Artificial Intelligence). Thank you for praying for the success of this Event.

I express deep gratitude for the invaluable role women religious play in pastoral work in the Diocese. May this day serve as a moment to acknowledge and honor women's contributions in the Church.

Special thanks to our religious Sisters who along with social workers, coordinators and animators work hard for women empowerment. You are also requested to observe March 10, Sunday as Women's Day in the parish. The Programmes of ORBIT will be on March 12th at Basavakalyan, 16th at Bhalki, 23rd at Humnabad.

Anniversary of the Election as Supreme Pontiff Pope Francis (March 13): Cardinal George Mario Bergoglio was chosen as the 266th pontiff in the Church on 13th March 2013 and inspired by the great example of St Francis of Assisi, he chose to be called Francis'. We thank God for his leadership in the church and throughout the world. Let us earnestly pray God to bless him with good health and guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Solemnity of St Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary (March 19): St Joseph is the patron saint of the Catholic Church, fathers, migrants, workers and also many Parishes and Institutions in our Diocese. He is portrayed as a just man and a model of faith for all believers. He is also recognized as a worker, symbolizing fulfilment through service to others, making his life an example for all engaged in various forms of work. I invite the youth in every parish to take initiative to celebrate the Feast of St Joseph honouring their own fathers during the celebration. Let us all entrust our mission diocese to his care.

#### **Chrism Mass**

Chrism Mass will be celebrated on **Thursday, 21**<sup>st</sup> **March 2024** at **Cathedral.** It is a blessed occasion we all come together, particularly the priests along with Bishop united in Christ the High Priest to bless the Holy Oils of Chrism, Catechumen and Anointing the Sick and experience the joy of the *Unum Presbyterium*.

It is also a day of Prayer and Recollection for all the Priests and the Religious. Rev. Fr Stanislaus, Professor at St Peter's Pontifical Seminary, Bangalore, has kindly consented to be the resource person of the day. The day's programme will begin with the prayer at 09.30 AM and will end with the Chrism Mass at 05.00 PM. I request all of you to be present. Just as we prepare our people, let us also spiritually prepare ourselves for the celebration of the Paschal *Triduum*.

Please exhort our faithful to participate in the Chrism Mass. Mission Centre Directors, please remember to bring Holy Oil containers. The programme details will be sent to you soon.

**Holy Week and Easter:** We begin the Holy Week on Sunday 24th March. I wish and pray the liturgy at your parish/mission becomes a faith experience and catechesis to all the faithful. Please prepare well all things especially Word of God you are preaching on these solemn celebrations. The Paschal *Triduum* begins at sunset on Holy Thursday when Christ accomplishes the work of Redemption and enters into the glory. We commemorate the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord observing the Solemn Liturgy of the Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil/Easter Sunday. Please read diligently the instructions given in the ORDO as well as the Missal before you celebrate the Easter *Triduum*, and your liturgy of *Triduum* will become meaningful, beautiful and according to the mind of the church. Wish you all a meaningful Paschal *Triduum*.

I extend heartfelt Easter blessings to each of you. Kindly convey my Easter greetings to your beloved parishioners and fellow members of your religious communities. May the Risen Lord enrich our lives with His blessings of happiness, serenity, and optimism as we continue to fulfill the divine mission bestowed upon us.

**Live Way of the Cross: Santpur Mission Team** with the collaboration of the youth of Aurad zone will be organizing on Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> March at 05:00 PM at Holy Cross Mission, Santpur. There will be Adoration, Sacrament of Confession and Healing Prayer.

**Bidar Mission Team** will be organizing on Good Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> March from 10:30 AM to 01:30 PM at Sai Ground (Opp. Stadium), Bidar. I request you all to encourage the youth of the zone and all people to participate in this spiritual journey.

**Faith Formation Camp:** to be held at your Missions/Parishes from 29th March to 4th April 2024 for all the children from Std IV to IX. The Commission for the Catechetics has prepared the lessons and other teaching material for you. These lessons provide you with only the required basic material. The teacher must study them, take pain to prepare the lessons suitable to the class one is teaching adding his or her faith-experience. You can enrich the lesson by giving better examples, adding appropriate songs, action songs, dramatization etc. Make your lessons more and more experiential and let it be a joyful faith experience for our children receiving the knowledge of faith, values and convictions.

The children selected for the Sankalpa Camp are exempted from this. They will have something similar here.

**PRERANA Camp:** You are welcome to hold *Prerana* Camp between April 14<sup>th</sup> to May 10<sup>th</sup> for all the children from 1<sup>st</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> Standard desiring to study especially those deprived of good education in the villages. The afternoon time can be utilized to help children to know their talents organizing various faith formation and cultural activities. Let there be Prayer, *Bhajans*, Mass and Rosary every day. Please engage good teachers and able Camp Masters. Also, please get the budget approved before you begin the camp.

**House Blessing:** The practice of House Blessing is a beautiful tradition preserved for centuries in the Church. Visiting the parishioners in their homes during the Easter time, the parish priest represents the Risen Lord meeting his people in the families bringing forgiveness, peace and hope of a new life with the Lord. I request all the parish priests to begin Family Blessings soon after Easter and complete the same before the Easter Season ends.

**Family Prayer Books:** The Family Prayer books are available in the Bishop's office. I request you to introduce them to the people in your parish.

**Parish/Mission Level Evaluation:** The annual evaluation of the pastoral plan activities will take place on 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of March. The directors are requested to send the reports along with the annual budget by 15<sup>th</sup> April.

**Election Enrolment:** As by now many of our youth and all the social workers are trained to register the names of the voters, I request all the parish priests to organize registration at the parish soon after the coming Sunday/Weekday Mass. For Gulbarga zone, training is arranged at the Cathedral on Saturday, 02 March at 03:00 PM. Directors, please send your representatives.

**Legal Cell:** Present socio-political situation calls us for preparedness to face the challenges that may arise on our way ahead. It's found urgent that every diocese should form a Legal Cell to take up issues affecting our Christian community. Therefore, a legal cell that aims at preparedness to face atrocities on the Church, organizing legal awareness, offering legal consultation in specific cases, and building up good rapport with the legal fraternity at the Taluka and District headquarters is formed under the leadership of Fr Vincent Pereira along with Fr Prashant Sequeira SJ assisted by Sr Vasantha SSpS, Adv.
