Rev. Fr Anil Prasad, Coordinator KRPPC and Rev. Fr Santhosh Dias, Secretary for National Level Health Commission, have graciously agreed to lead this event as the resource team. The Convention, at Bidar themed "ಜೊತೆಜೊತೆಯಾಗಿ ನಡೆಯೋಣ, ಧರ್ಮಸಭೆಯ ಬೆಳೆಸೋಣ" will commence on Saturday 3rd August at 06:00PM and conclude on the

following day, Sunday by 04:00 PM. I invite all the Priests, Sisters, PPC, PFC & VPC Members to attend this significant event. We aim for equal participation of both men and women members in the convention.

I request your prayers for the success of these Conventions.

1. The Feast of St John Mary Vianney, (August 04): Saint John Vianney was a French Catholic priest who is best known for his dedicated pastoral work in the small village of Ars in France. Despite facing various challenges, he worked tirelessly to minister to the spiritual needs of his parishioners and became renowned for his holiness, asceticism, and ability to bring about conversions. Pope Pius XI canonized John Vianney in 1925, and he was later proclaimed the patron saint of parish priests in 1929. On this special occasion, I extend my heartfelt wishes to all my fellow priests as we celebrate the Feast of our Patron, St. John Marie Vianney. I feel happy to see you my brother priests working with great devotion and commitment in various parishes, missions and institutions, and I believe that this brings you a profound sense of fulfillment. Inspired by St. John Marie Vianney, let us continue our work with zeal, praying for the conversion of our people. Ignite their hearts through the sacraments of confession, inspiring homilies, devout celebration of the Eucharist, family visits, and catechism classes for children. I request the Sisters and PPC members to organize a special greeting for their parish priests on Sunday, August 4th.

2. Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord (August 06): This event is recorded in three of the four canonical Gospels: Matthew 17:1-8, Mark 9:2-8, and Luke 9:28-36. It signifies the revelation of Jesus' divine glory and his true nature as the Son of God. The affirmation from the Father confirmed Jesus' identity as the Son of God, underscoring his authority and mission as the Savior and Messiah, while also foreshadowing his resurrection. The appearance of Moses and Elijah alongside Jesus symbolizes the continuity of God's plan of salvation throughout history encouraging the believers to remain steadfast in faith amidst trials.

3. Feast of St Lawrence the Martyr (August 10): St Lawrence, a prominent figure in early Christianity, is celebrated for his martyrdom and his exemplary service to the Church, particularly in the context of charity and care for the poor. As a deacon, Lawrence was responsible for the distribution of alms and care for the poor in Rome. His famous act of presenting the poor as the true treasures of the Church when ordered to hand over the Church's riches exemplifies his dedication to charity. His life serves as an inspiration for the Church's mission to serve those in need and to live out the Gospel message.

4. National Youth Sunday (August 11): The Church across India celebrates National Youth Sunday, a day dedicated to the youth. Much like World Youth Day and Asian Youth Day, this occasion highlights the remarkable energy and faith that young people infuse into our community. This year's theme is particularly inspiring: "Those who hope in the Lord will run and not grow weary" (*Isaiah 40:31*). I request all the Mission Directors and Parish Priest to celebrate this Youth Sunday meaningfully in your mission centers and parishes.

5. Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary/Independence Day (August 15): The entire Church exalts the Creator in celebration of the Glorious Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. By her immaculate conception, Mary was preserved from sin, and throughout her life, she faithfully fulfilled her divine mission. In recognition of her purity and devotion, God assumed her into Heaven, body and soul, and crowned her as Queen of Heaven and Earth. This feast of Our Lady brings to light the challenges in the Christian journey and calls us to faithfully cooperate with God's plan in our own lives. Let us earnestly seek the powerful intercession of our Blessed Mother in our daily lives and remain blessed.

As we also mark the 78th Independence Day of our nation, we take pride in this monumental freedom, achieved through the sacrifices of countless individuals who gave their lives. Let us honor this dual celebration—the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven and our Independence Day joyfully and meaningfully.

6. Anniversary of the Diocese (August 18): Our Diocese will joyously step into 20th year since its formal inauguration in 2005. The Lord has abundantly blessed this diocese. Filled with gratitude let us continue to serve and enhance its vibrancy. This date also marks the anniversary of my Episcopal Ordination. I am deeply thankful for your support and cooperation in the past 19 years. I humbly request your prayers that I may continue to lead and serve this mission diocese with the heart of Jesus, the Good Shepherd.

7. Justice Sunday (August 18): This year, Justice Sunday will be observed on August 18, 2024, the Sunday following Independence Day. The CBCI Office for Justice, Peace, and Development has chosen the theme, *"Human Dignity Beyond Every*"

Question: A Call to Action for Justice." As we observe Justice Sunday, let us reaffirm our commitment to safeguarding human dignity in every aspect of life. May our churches shine as beacons of hope, where every person is valued as a beloved child of God. Let us move forward with the conviction that human dignity is not negotiable. It is the truth upon which we build a just, peaceful and compassionate society. I request all the Mission Directors and Parish Priest to celebrate this Justice Sunday meaningfully in your mission centers and parishes. The liturgy for this day will be sent to you soon.

News July 2024

Blessing of the New Grotto and Parish Feast at St Thomas Church, Shahabad (July 07, 2024): St Thomas Church in Shahabad witnessed a significant event with the blessing of the newly erected grotto. The ceremony was graced by the Bishop, who imparted his blessings upon the grotto, marking it as a sacred space for the community. This solemn occasion coincided with the celebration of the Parish Feast, where Bishop presided as the principal celebrant, leading the congregation in a day of spiritual reflection and festivity.

Inauguration of Newly Built St Ambrose High School at Wadi (*July 10, 2024*): The newly constructed St Ambrose High School building was inaugurated and blessed by the Bishop in the presence of the Provincial Superior, Fathers, Sisters, and the school staff. Following the inauguration, Bishop celebrated the Holy Eucharist and delivered a homily emphasizing the importance of education as a foundational element in the lives of students.

MCA Animators Training (July 13, 14, 2024): A training session for Missionary Childhood Association (MCA) animators was held at Holy Cross Church, Santpur and Sacred Heart Church, Bidar on 13 and 14 July, respectively catering to the Aurad and Bidar Zones. Over 40 lay animators benefitted from the training programme. The session aimed to enhance the skills and knowledge of the animators, ensuring better guidance and support for the children in their respective communities.

Photoshop Poster Design Workshop Organized by Premavani Communications (July 17, 2024): Premavani Communications of the Gulbarga Diocese organized a one-day workshop on Photoshop poster design at the Sevasangama Social Development Center on July 17, 2024. The workshop saw enthusiastic participation from 13 attendees, led by Fr Roshan D' Souza. The training aimed to enhance participants' skills in poster design, promoting creative and effective communication within the community.

YUVA SPANDANA 2024 (July 14 & 21, 2024): Holy Cross Church, Santpur and Sacred Heart Church, Bidar hosted the YUVA SPANDANA 2024 programme for the Aurad and Bidar Zone on 14th and 21st July respectively under the theme "Unity and Diversity: Celebrating Our Commonality and Differences." The event saw the enthusiastic participation of over 150 youth members. The program aimed to foster a sense of unity and appreciation for diversity among the youth, highlighting the importance of celebrating both commonalities and differences within the community.

NECROLOGY

Mr A. Lourdunathan (78 Years), F/o Rev. Fr Praveen Joseph, Parish Priest, Mother of Divine Grace Cathedral, Gulbarga passed away on 25 July 2024. May the Lord receive him in His Eternal abode. Our heartfelt condolences to dear Fr Joseph Praveen and his family members.

THE PRIEST WHO THOUGHT HE FAILED: The parish priest of a small town arrived at the church encouraged and motivated to perform another evening Mass, but the hour passed and the town did not come. After 15 minutes delay, three children entered, after 20 minutes two young people entered. So the priest decided to start the mass with the five people. Over the course of Mass, a couple came in who sat on the last benches of the church. When the priest preached and explained the Gospel, another half-dirty person came in with a rope in his hand. Disappointed and not understanding the cause of the weak involvement of the faithful, the priest celebrated Mass with love and preached with enthusiasm and zeal. On his way back home he was robbed and beaten by two thieves who stole his folder where his Bible and other valued belongings were. Arriving at the parish house and bandaging his wounds, he described that day as: The saddest day of my life, a failure of my ministry, and the most unfruitful day of my career; but... never mind, I do everything with God and for Him.

After five years, the priest decided to share this story with parishioners at church. When he was finished telling the story, a couple in that parish stopped him and said, " Father, the couple in the story that sat at the back was us. We were on the brink of separation because of several problems and disagreements in our home. That night we finally decided to divorce, but first we decided to come to church one last time as a couple and then each one would follow their path. Meanwhile, we left the thought of divorce aside after listening to your homily that same night. As a result, today we are here with our home and family restored ".

As the couple spoke, one of the most successful entrepreneurs who helped in the livelihoods of people of that church saluted, asking to speak. And giving him the opportunity, the entrepreneur said, "Father, I am the person who came in half dirty with a rope in my hand. I was on the verge of bankruptcy, lost in drugs, my wife and my kids had left home on account of my behavior. That night I tried to kill myself but the rope broke so I went out to buy another one. When I got on my way, I saw the church open, I decided to come in even though I was really dirty and had a rope in my hand. That night, your homily pierced my heart and I walked out of here a changed person. Today I'm off the drugs, my family came home and I became the most successful businessman in the town." At the gate of the sacristy entrance, the Deacon shouted, "Father, I was one of those thieves that stole your belongings. The other one died that same night while we were doing the second robbery. In his briefcase, there was a Bible. I read it every time I woke up in the morning. After all this reading, I decided to apply it to my life and participate in this church."

The priest was shocked and started crying along with the faithful. After all, the night he regarded as a night of failure was the most fruitful of his ministry.

Reflection: Exercise your calling (work / mission) with dedication and zeal. Give it your best every day, because you are an instrument of good for someone's life. In the worst days of your life you can still be a blessing to someone else. God can use the " bad circumstances " of a life to produce the best for others.
