Holy Father's Intention for the Month: For vocations to the priesthood and religious life: Let us pray that the ecclesial community might welcome the desires and doubts of those young people who feel a call to serve Christ's mission in the priesthood and religious life.

Dear Fathers, Sisters and Brethren, Jai Christ!

1. Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life (Feb 02):The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, celebrated on February 2nd, marks the occasion when Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord, in accordance with the Law of Moses. On this day, the liturgy encourages a procession where the faithful hold lighted candles, symbolizing Christ as the light of the world, and includes the blessing of candles.

This feast is closely linked to the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life, as both emphasize Christ's dedication to the Father and the significance of the consecrated life within the Church. It serves as a reminder of the virtues of obedience to God's will, along with the poverty and chastity embraced by those who dedicate themselves to a consecrated life. On this special day, we offer prayers for all religious priests, sisters, and brothers serving in our diocese, expressing heartfelt gratitude for their invaluable service and collaboration in the mission of the Church.

Day of the Consecrated Life will be celebrated at the diocesan level on Saturday 8th February 2025 at Mother of Divine Grace Cathedral, Gulbarga. As we are celebrating this as a Jubilee Year programme, I invite all the <u>Diocesan and</u> <u>Religious Priests, Sisters and Brothers</u> serving this diocese to attend the celebration.

2. MCA and Youth Jubilee 2025: MCA Jubilee programme on 12-14 January 2025 and Youth Jubilee programme on 24-26 January 2025 was a grand success. Thanks to Directors, animators, Fr Abhishek Moses, Secretary of Evangelization Commission and Fr Sachin Christy, Secretary of Youth Commission for their tireless efforts that made it a memorable event. We are indeed happy about children participating so well in the liturgy, talks, praying and various educative entertainments. Happy to note, children have contributed Rs. 28,118.00 as their contribution to Pontifical Society of Holy Childhood. Our youth are now ready to organize programmes in their respective missions and parishes. Please give them the 'space' and opportunities to serve the community in the village or parish or mission level.

3. CCBI General Body Meeting: 36th Plenary Assembly of CCBI is being held from 27th January to 4th February at XIM University Bubaneshwar, Odisha with the theme: "Discerning Synodal Pathways for Mission". Please pray for this assembly of the Bishops (CCBI) and the meeting to be fruitful.

4. Deanery Review Meetings: As deanery recollections will go along with Day of the Consecrated, I request the Deans to hold half yearly review of Parish Pastoral Plan Implementation – Evaluation and Reporting on Thursday 13th with following Agenda:

- 1. Parish Pastoral Plan Evaluation and Reporting.
- 2. Basic Ecclesial Community: Plan for the Deanery Level Jubilee programme and propose two convenient dates.
- 3. Family Commission: Plan for the Deanery Level Marriage enrichment programme and propose two convenient dates.

Deans will submit the report by 25th February 2025 and will also collaborate with the respective Secretaries to organize the proposed programmes.

5. Jubilee Cross: Please note, as mentioned in the last circular, the Jubilee Cross will be taken to all Catholic families in the respective Zones. However, I am not sure whether it has been planned according to the circular issued last month. Zonal leaders are requested to submit the programme to the chancery at the earliest

6. Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes (Feb 11): This feast commemorates the apparitions of the Virgin Mary to Saint Bernadette Soubirous in Lourdes, France, in 1858. It was at Lourdes that Our Lady called herself "the Immaculate Conception" and gave the world her message that we must repent for our sins. We also celebrate this day as the 'World Day of the Sick'. Saint John Paul II instituted the World Day of the Sick on this day of the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes to pray for the sick. This day is a significant event in the Catholic Church that emphasizes the importance of prayer, closeness and care for the sick. Let's then on this day offer our prayers for people suffering due to various illnesses and those who care for the sick.

7. From the Procurator: The Interim Audit for the Diocese of Gulbarga and CDSB is scheduled to commence in the first week of February 2025. I request everyone who has not vet submitted their accounts to do so at the earliest.

Two Renovated Chapels Blessed at Santpur Mission (*January 11, 2025***):** Nagoor and Manigempur villages, part of the Santpur Mission, witnessed a day of joy and celebration as two renovated chapels were blessed. The Holy Family Church in Nagoor was blessed in the morning and later that evening, the Holy Rosary Church in Manigempur was blessed by the bishop in the presence of a large gathering of faithful. Fr Lawrence Arun, the Director of Santpur Mission, and his team were specially commended for their hard work in renovating the church.

Chinnara Mahotsav 2025 Marks a Joyful Start to Jubilee Year 2025 (*January 12-14,* **2025):** The Missionary Childhood Association (MCA) inaugurated its Jubilee Year 2025 with *Chinnara Mahotsav*, held from January 12 to 14 at the Infant Jesus Shrine, Bhalki.
